An issue has arisen relating to the play equipment located on the Lower Recreation Ground, adjacent to Western Way. New Health and Safety requirements directed at improving the safety of children using the equipment are placing a legal obligation on the Parish Council to fence and gate the area. It will have a significant effect on the appearance of the area and raises concerns relating to amenity of the general area, and traffic safety at a dangerous junction.

The Parish Council is seeking the views of Winsham residents prior to a possible Public Meeting that will be held when the Highways Dept. have reported on traffic safety issues. The Parish Council will be pleased to explain the issues in greater detail to Winsham residents, and obtain their initial views on this matter.
