

Hi all,

Things got a bit quieter for me this week, so I decided to spend some time on a few outstanding jobs on the web sites. Part of this is in response to the new Parish Council Web Site that will be making its appearance, probably before Christmas.

This web site will be devoted entirely to Parish Council matters, as we now have a statutory obligation to publish all sorts of information in the interests of transparency. It will also carry a lot of the information that currently appears in the Parish Council section of the Winsham Parish Web Site, so when it is launched, the Parish Council section on the parish web site will be discontinued.

One of the tasks that was overdue was to update and review the 'visits' statistics relating to the various sections of the Winsham web site. I was amazed to find that these have increased by 100% over the last two years. We now have an average of 980 visits each month-three visits per household. The links from the e-letter clearly contribute a lot to this. A good proportion of people visiting view the parish council area, and Market Place, and also, of course, the Notice Board. Last week nearly a hundred people visited the Parish Council area, probably following the receipt of the e-letter.

Indications also point to the growing popularity of our social media links-Facebook and Twitter. To help everyone move between all our resources, the link 'bar' that you see below will soon be found on many of the pages of the Winsham web sites, to help visitors move easily between them. They are all part of the 'Winsham on the Web' family.
