The red-tape associated with the co-option or the election of Parish Councillors to fill the two vacancies has started, and in the e-letter you will find a link to a statutory notice that you should read, if you are a registered elector of Winsham Parish. The whole process is quite long and drawn out, taking at least a couple of months, which is one of the reasons that John and I retired when we did.

On other Parish Council matters, the new web site is beginning to come into its own. It carries the detail of the changes to the Parish Council, and also, for the first time carries the approved Minutes of the previous meeting. Personally I hope it will also soon publish draft minutes for the preceding month, as in the past, as this give important information to the parish residents more quickly, enabling them to respond if they wish by attending the Public Forum for the next meeting, rather than having to wait for a moth for the next meeting.
