The e-letter mailing list is confidential, and I intend that it should stay that way. However I have had a request from Winsham Shop for help in contacting their Shareholders and Loan Note holders.

The ability to reach the shop's financial supporters relatively quickly is becoming more important, especially in the months ahead, while the possible purchase of 'The Bell' is being explored.

A significant number of e-mail addresses are not known to the Shop's Management Committee, and as quite a proportion of the shop's financial supporters are subscribers to the e-letter, I have been asked if I would be prepared to give the shop's management committee access to these addresses.

My question to the readers of the e-letter who are concerned-shareholders and loan note holders, is do you have any objection to my doing this?

Winsham Shop have confirmed that they will be kept confidential, and will only be used for the types of communications indicated above. By agreeing, you will save the Winsham Shop Management Committee-all volunteers-a great deal of work and help speed -up communication. Of course some of the shop's financial supporters do not have an e-mail service, and they will be sent communications as in the past.

All this seems reasonable to me, so I am asking for your agreement.

If you do NOT want me to pass your e-mail address to the Shop's management committee, please let me know as soon as possible-ideally within the next seven days.
