

Hi All,

Winsham's high speed Broadband seems to be settling down, with few horror stories, and little increase in the cost from the 'peddle power' service we have been experiencing since broadband came to Winsham in 2004 or thereabouts. Speeds are disappointing compared with what we were told we should get, but in practice a 35Mb/s download is adequate for most of us, and the 55Mb/s that was suggested we should have, would never have been fast enough for those who need a really high speed service-mostly for specialised business and enthusiastic gamers.

The next big item on the Winsham agenda is support (or otherwise) of the proposal that Winsham Shop should buy 'The Bell' in order to secure the future of both. Next Saturday you will be able to visit the Jubilee Hall to get answers to any questions you have, and see the detail of what is proposed. You can also get a similar opportunity if you visit the Jubilee Cafe on the following Thursday, 16th February.

The Weather doesn't look too good! It hasn't been too good during the last week either. However, it did give me the opportunity to bring together the full unexpurgated story of how the Jubilee Hall survived its crisis in 2004 and had a life-saving renovation in 2005 and 2006.
