At long last the Emergency Exit doors at the front of Jubilee Hall have been refurbished to make them draught proof, while continuing to make them as 'user friendly' as possible for disabled access. They will also be given a fresh coat of paint. The doors are a good example of recycling. The doors started life in 1887, when they were one door, opening inwards. Some 100 years later, they were converted into two doors, opening outwards, to meet new fire regulations. Now they have had a major refurbishment, which will greatly improve the heat efficiency of the hall, and make it more comfortable to use during the winter months.
