Hi All,

A lot to tell you about in this week's e-letter, so I am breaking it up into headed paragraphs for your convenience.

Winsham Shop and Post Office and Winsham Parish Council

The consideration of the three planning applications relating to 'The George Project' are on the agenda for next Wednesday's Parish Council Meeting, as well as a full agenda of other items. In view of the public interest and the length of the Agenda there has been a change in the usual time for Parish Council meetings from 7.30pm to 7.00pm. on this occasion. It will

also take place in the main hall, not the Committee Room to facilitate the anticipated public interest.

It is important that the Parish Council is aware of resident's views on the Agenda items, so if you have something to say, come along and say it. There is a Public Forum before the start of the formal Parish Council meeting to provide this opportunity. If you can't make the meeting, you can send an e-mail to the Parish Clerk outlining your views and the councillors will be made aware of them-but don't leave it until the last minute.

There is also an associated and important up-date from the Winsham Shop and Management Committee which can be seen from the e-letter link below. It includes an appeal for people supporting 'The George Project' to let their views be known to the Planning Dept of SSDC, and tells us how to do this. Unfortunately, the details of the three relevant planning applications are not yet posted on the SSDC web site, but should be very soon. You can also make your views known to the Parish Council, as outlined earlier. When Planning details are on line, the link will be given on the Parish Web site and in the e-letter.

I expect a regular flow of news on 'The George Project' from now on, after a fairly quiet period, so keep watching this space.
