News of another scam is reported in the Neighbourhood Watch area of the web site-there is a link below.

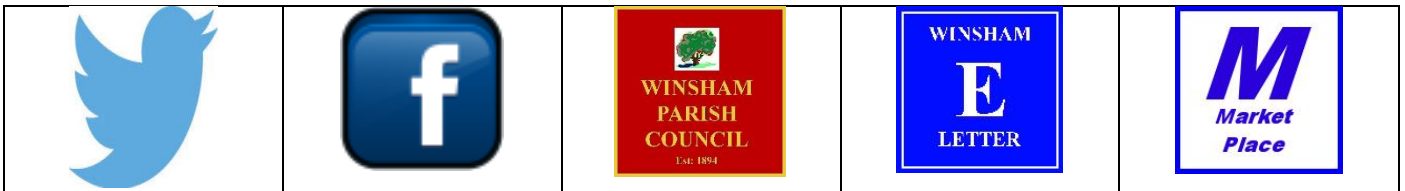
