Hi all,

The first major parish events since the lockdown started some fifteen or so months ago were a real success; the weather, against the odds, was kind to us, providing an ideal combination of gentle warmth and sunshine, encouraging both Winsham residents and others from far and wide to enjoy themselves, albeit in a calm relaxed manner.

The Open Gardens event, and the Scarecrow Competition which happened yesterday might not have had the vitality and excitement of the Winsham Street Fair that had originally been scheduled for the weekend, had not Covid -19 intervened, but they did break the isolation 'spell' under which we have all been living to some degree or other for a very long time. What's more we have other events on the calendar for the end of August to which we can all look forward.

The winners of the 'My Hero' Scarecrow competition can be found below, provided very quickly to the E-letter by Sally Lines; Deborah Murray will be providing information about the success of Winsham Horticultural Society's Open Garden's event next week. We must be grateful to both for the enormous energy that they invested to ensure the success of the events. Thanks also to all the other people too, who made the effort to enter their gardens or used their imagination and skill to construct the scarecrows, or who helped in some way to make the day a bit special.

On Tuesday evening the Jubilee Hall Management Committee convened the first AGM since the Coronavirus outbreak in early 2020. Last year the Jubilee Hall Annual Report 2019/2020 was published on-line, but the public meeting was at first postponed and then abandoned. The Annual Report 2020/2021 that was presented to the meeting in precis form-due to the continuing need to wear masks-was published in full on the Parish Web site, including accounts, shortly before the meeting. The committee remains unchanged, and at the Ordinary Meeting that followed, the existing Officers agreed to continue with their responsibilities.

The Minutes of both meetings will be published as soon as possible, but my web software has been attacked by gremlins, and it is not one of the minor skirmishes that I often have; this looks like a full-blown war, which eventually I shall win, but I would not like to speculate as to when! At present there is a strategic withdrawal on my part, which means that none of the last fifteen years of minutes are accessible on the web site. I will keep you posted as to progress. Both the Hon. Sec-Sarah Gleadell and I have copies, which can be inspected on request. Only the web site is affected.

Henk Beentje's articles and pictures, describing his themed botanical walks around the parish continue with his contribution for June. They are proving to be very popular. Sadly, Liz Earl is leaving the village, so Henk has agreed to extend the botany observations to include some of the fauna as well. We all remember the butterfly census on which both Liz and Henk collaborated in 2019 for Winsham Web Museum.

On the Parish Council, Jim Everard is the new Chairman of the Council, and it is hoped that we really do get an easing of the restrictions in July, so that the August meeting may well be back to something close to normal. It is hoped that the Certificates for the winners of the various elements of the Grand Winsham Challenge 2021 will be presented with their certificates at the September meeting.

On Monday morning the new system for collecting Rubbish will start. No doubt most people know about it, as leaflets have been pushed through letterboxes, and big blue bags distributed.
