### 101. Apologies for absence.

### 102. Minutes.

The Minutes of the Meeting held on the 12th March 1993 were signed

### 103. Matters arising.

PLAQUE FOR OLD LAMP POST. The Clerk had obtained a Quotation for this.  
In metal or plastic the cost will be £7. It was agreed to order the  
plaque in plastic. Size 6" x 2".

### 104. Planning.

YSJ Seeds. Agricultural Workers dwelling on land OS 7839 Part.  
The Winsham Planning Committee have objected to this proposal and  
have recommended refusal.

### 105. Finance.

At this point the Clerk was asked to 'phone Mr Slade asking him to  
expedite the works of installing the Safety Surfaces in the Childrens  
Recreation Ground.

### 106. Mr C Baigent.

Mr Baigent will contact Mr Jones of the District Council Cleansing Dept  
requesting serious cleaning in Pools Lane.  
Regarding the request for a Licence to hold a 24 hour Dance at Cricket  
St. Thomas. A Public Meeting on this subject is to be held and Mr Baigent  
has suggested the venue should be the Jubilee Hall in Winsham.  
A letter from Mrs S Flanagan was read. She is complainung about dangers  
in the Childrens Recreation Ground. A reply will state that this Council  
are continually giving safety matters consideration. The Distrinct Council  
Inspector visits the Site regularly and the District Councillor is  
looking into the matter of Grants for Safety items.
