10. Apologies for absence.

Were received from Mr K Fowler, Mrs J Gowers and Mr C Baigent (Dist. Cllr.).

11. Minutes.

Following an alteration to Minute No.5, the Minutes of the Meeting on the 14th May 1993 were signed as a true record.

12. Matters arising.

OLD LAMP POST. Mr Slade has this matter in hand. The Clerk gave the Plaque to Mr Slade.

GRASS CUTTING. Mrs Loaring has asked Mr Smith to cut the grass each fortnight whilst there is a heavy growth.
The Small Recreation Ground will be cut shortly before the Street Fair on the 26th June.

13. Police.

Not present. Mrs Loaring said there had been a burglary in the Village yesterday but had no details.
A Police Motorcyclist with a 'Radar Gun' was in the Village last Tuesday. Mrs Loaring said the Police were looking for a Tramp on a bicycle. He is wanted in connection with the stabbing of a Roman Catholic Priest in Kent. A person of this description has been in Winsham.

14. Planning.

Mr C Baigent, Haytor, Winsham. Intent to carry out tree surgery. Allowed.

Mr Slade raised the subject of trenches across roads around the Village which are subsiding.

The District Council have requested a hearing regarding the All Night Dance Event at Cricket St Thomas to be held in September.
