51. Apologies for absence.

52. Minutes.

After a deletion on Min. No.39, the Minutes of the meeting on the 13th September 1991 were signed as a true record.

53. Matters arising.

Maintenance of Council Houses and Trees in Davies Close. These subjects will be discussed on Agenda No.7 - Mr C Baigent.

'Know your Village' Trail. 33 took part in this event and it was voted a success. Mr and Mrs R Rose obtained the highest marks.

P.C. Mazzei had patrolled the Village on foot for about 2 hours.

Play Equipment. Mr Fowler has made enquiries about Safety Matting for the swings. It is reported that a Grant of 75% can be obtained from the District Council. Mr C Baigent will check on this and Mr Slade will calculate how many mats would be necessary. An application will then be made to the Shell 'Better Britain' Campaign to cover the cost.

Damage to the road surface at Ebben Lane. Mr Trickett has contacted the Highways Division. See Min. No.58.

The Clerk was asked to write to the Highways Division, drawing their attention to the poor state of the road following works by the Water Board.

It was reported that the Police Traffic Division had carried out two speed checks in the Village. One on the 24th September at the corner of Davies Close at 11.30 a.m. til 12.30 p.m. when 6 cars were stopped and another check on the 7th October at the bottom of Church Street and then on the corner of Davies Close at 5 p.m. til 6.15 p.m. About 8 cars were stopped at Davies Close.

58. Mr J Trickett.

Mr Trickett had 'phoned the Clerk. He said he had contacted Highways regarding Ebben Lane. An investigation will be made. He also requested 'SLOW' signs to be painted at the Cross Roads.

He had also seen the Street Light Officer of the County Council. The Grant will be paid shortly.

Some minor repairs will be carried out at the School and School Transport is under discussion. This is regarding the limits for free travel.

60. Shell 'Better Britain' Campaign.

Research will be made for Safety Matting for the swings. See Min. No.53. Mr Wilson suggested some additional street lighting may be a good subject for a Grant.
