Minutes of the Winsham Parish Council meeting on Friday, 8th August 1986 at 8.00 p.m. in the Jubilee Hall.

### 38. Apologies for absence.

Were received from Mr C Slade, Mr V Chubb and Mr L Fisher (Dist: Cllr.)

### 39. Minutes,

The minutes of the meeting on 11th July 1986 were signed as a true record.

### 40. Matters arising.

Ref: Min: 28 - Damage to War Memorial. No estimate received from Mr C Slade.

Ref: Min: 28 - Resiting of new Litter Bin. Nothing done by Mr V Chubb.

Ref: Min: 30 - No.32 Western Way, Winsham. It is reported that Mr Miller is proposing to buy the property.

Ref: Min: 31 - Cemetery Path Fence. No reply from Mr McCallum. This matter will be kept in mind.

Ref: Min: 32 - Lowering swing frames. No estimates received. P H Hardwill stated he cannot see his way clear to start the work before October 1986. He will be asked to tender for this but not the work of installing the Kissing Gate.

Ref: Min: 33 - Kissing Gate. K D J Slade & Sons have been asked to tender for the installation of this and the lowering of the swing frames.

Ref: Min: 34 - Church Clock. Mr Ingram of Bridgwater has been asked to look into this matter.

Ref: Min: 37 - The Clerk has seen Mrs Howers regarding her seeing the Definitive Maps of Winsham.

### 41. Planning.

861547 Conversion of Chapel at Court Street, Winsham into a dwelling. The Winsham Planning Committee has approved this application.

860979 Agricultural Workers dwelling at Whatley Lane, Chard. No reply received from the District Planning Officer.

### 42. Chard Local Plan.

Mrs Loaring commented briefly on the Plan and read some extracts. A Parish Council meeting will be held on Monday, 18th August 1986 to discuss the plan fully.

### 43. Wall at Right of Cemetery Path Entrance.

TRIP. An organisation to look into Public Transport. It was decided not to subscribe.

Somerset County Council Meeting details. Passed to Mr Woodward.

Somerset Structure Plan. Questionnaires received. A copy handed to each Councillor for personal comments. The Plan will be discussed at the meeting on the 18th August 1986.

47. Any other business.

Mrs Fowler said the Cemetery hedge needs cutting. Also the rubbish bin needs emptying. The two items will be on the Agenda for the meeting on 12th September 1986.

Mr Bannen has been approached about displaying the Agenda on the Notice Board. This will be done in future.

Street Nameplates - Western Way. One of these has been stolen and the other loosened on its fixings. This has been reported to the District Council and the Police.

It was suggested that extracts from the Parish Council meeting minutes should be included in the Parish Magazine. This will be discussed at the meeting on 12th September 1986.
