### 27. Matters arising.

Small Recreation Ground Fence. Mr Fisher is dealing with this.  
Senior Igloo. Mrs Fowler will remind Mr Gibbons.  
Footpath Marker Posts. Mr Pym wishes to leave this until later in the year.  
Concrete at the Kissing Gate. This has been completed.
