98. Public Question Time.

Mr Roy Smart spoke on the subject of the Street Fair. At a Meeting last Monday the Jubilee Hall Management Committee decided this Years Fair will be postponed and they will not run any more Fairs unless a Committee can be formed with the help of the Parish Council. It was suggested a Meeting should be held in September 1995 to form a Committee to organise a Street Fair in 1996. This was agreed.

Area West Committee. The Clerk was asked to write asking for a Meeting to be held in Winsham.


109. Any other business.
