

WINSHAM PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the Winsham Parish Council Meeting held on the 10th June 1994 at 8.00 p.m. in the Jubilee Hall.

13. Public Question Time.

Mrs S J Paigent spoke. She and some other ladies wish to form a Committee to purchase play equipment for the Childrens Playing Field. A 10000 budget is envisaged. A 50% Grant can be obtained from the District Council and a donation will be sought from the Parish Council. The Committee will raise money by holding various functions. A quotation for equipment will be received shortly. Mr Fowler and Mr Speyer will join the Committee representing the Parish Council. The subject will be on the next Agenda.

14. Apologies for absence.

Were received from Mrs M Hoaring and Mrs E Jones.

15. Minutes.

The Minutes of the Meeting on the 15th May 1994 were signed as a true record.

16. Matters arising.

Grass Cutting. It is considered the last cut was much better.
'Fulwood', Ebben Lane re: Tall. A reply awaited.
Traffic Calming at Forton. It is considered the 'Humps' are still not up to standard despite recent works. Another letter of complaint will be sent. Mr A A Pike. The use of land for Logging Business etc.: A map received from the Planning Office appears to show this Application is situated in the Parish of Chaffcombe.
The Clerk has notified the District Council and the SALC about the change of Chairman of the Parish Council. The District Council seem to think the Clerk has changed because Post which should come to the Clerk is now being addressed to the Chairman. This error will be dealt with.
Re-opening the Churchyard for burials. Mrs Jones will be contacted.
Increasing the size of the Cemetery. Mr Speyer is still pursuing this.

17. Play Equipment.

It was decided to wait until the quotation arrives before a decision is made on how much the Parish Council will donate.
Mr Speyer has £70 which came from the sale of the book 'Winsham I Remember' by W H Paate. This will be donated.

19. Planning.

A new Application received. No. 941133 R C Smith and Partners, Broadenham Farm. To be discussed by the Planning Committee.

20. Finance.

Repairs to the War Memorial. Mr Ian John will examine the Memorial and provide a specification for repairs. The District Architects Dept. The Clerk was asked to contact Mr Whitmarsh of the County Council about Traffic Calming in Davies Close, Winsham.

Litter Bin. Mr Paigent brought a Bin which had been supplied by the District Council. It is free and will be installed on concrete by the District Council.

Trough by the Telephone Kiosk. This matter will be discussed further.

Mr Woodward suggested some trees should be provided.

Mr Paigent will pursue the Community Project Grant Scheme.

Barrier in the Small Recreation Ground. It was suggested that this should be incorporated with Play Equipment. Mr Fowler said he could provide a barrier if necessary.

To contact Mr Nicolas Debavory, the Clerk was told to contact Mr Barry for an address.

21. Mr C Paigent.

The installation of the standard light in the Western Way Car Park was decided by the Environmental Working Party with no consultation with the Parish Council.

Smoke Alarms and the possibility of emergency lighting will be fitted in the Sheltered housing bungalows in Davies Close. It was suggested that the Davies Close Common Room should be checked for Smoke Alarms.

A bolt close to the slide in the Small Recreation Ground needs to be removed.

22. Mr B Esp.

Mr Esp said the 'humps' at Forton were not legal in profile.

The new Highways Manager - Mr R J McWilliams - can be invited to a Parish Council Meeting if required. He will walk around the Village with Councillors to check works needed.

Mirror on the A30. No satisfactory answer yet.

Mrs Rose said a 'No through road' sign is needed at Pools Lane because visitors keep turning into the Lane thinking it is the way to Forde Abbey.

23. Pamphlet on walks.

Mr Fowler will contact Mr Roy Smart to see if a Pamphlet can be made of the Winsham Wander maps.

24. Year 2000 Celebrations.

A project is to be decided before putting any money aside.

Mrs Rose suggested a celebration should be considered for 1995 as the end of World War 2.


